

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS:

2019 Edna V. Folger Outstanding Teacher Award

Faurecia Emissions Control Technologies, the Community Education Coalition, and the IUPUC Center for Teaching and Learning are accepting nominations for the 2019 Edna V. Folger Outstanding Teacher Award. The award will be presented at the Columbus Area Chamber of Commerce Annual Meeting.

What is the Edna V. Folger Outstanding Teacher Award?

Edna Folger set the early standard for teachers. In her honor, the award was designed to raise awareness about the immeasurable influence teachers have on their students and to recognize the image of teachers as important community role models. Sponsored by Faurecia, the award includes a stipend of \$4,000, a personal award from the IUPUC Center for Teaching and Learning, and the recipient's name will be added to a permanent plaque located in the Columbus Learning Center.

Who is eligible to receive the award?

Any full-time elementary or secondary school teacher or educator working at a public, private, or parochial school in Bartholomew County is eligible to receive the award. This includes classroom, special education, or special subject teachers; certified educators; counselors; and administrators.

How do I nominate a teacher?

Any individual or group may nominate a classroom teacher or educator to receive this award. Nominations should include biographical information, reasons for nomination, letters of recommendation, and support materials. Nomination instructions are available from the IUPUC Center for Teaching and Learning, the Bartholomew Consolidated School Corporation Administrative Offices, and in the main office of schools throughout Bartholomew County.
