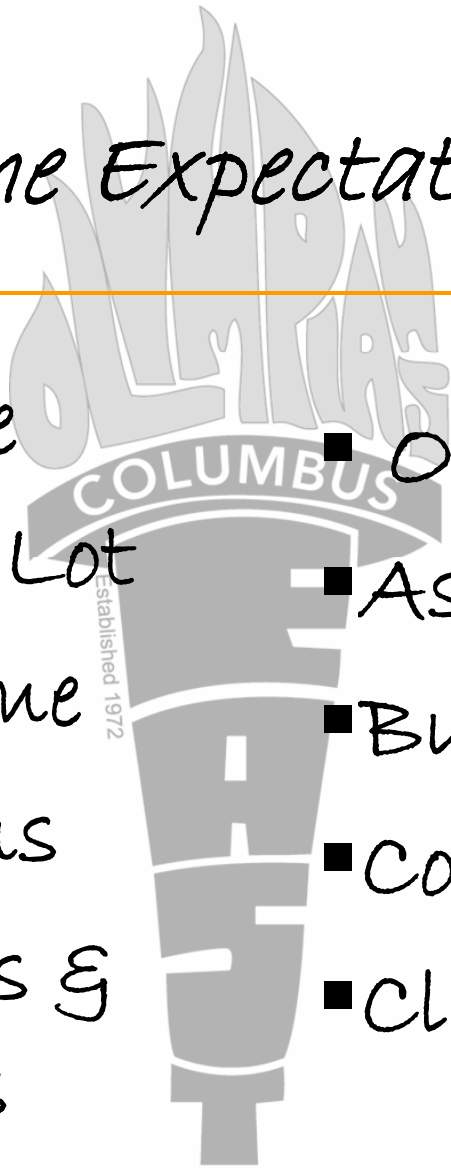

Take Care of Yourself	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be in a chair before the bell rings • Ask for help when it is needed • Bring necessary materials • Engage yourself in course related tasks • Ask for a pass before leaving resource 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Monitor your noise level • Keep your hands to yourself • Arrive to class on time • Have a pass if during class or resource 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be safe while off campus • Be on time for your next class • Only access locker level if you have a purpose – i.e. lockers/restroom 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wash your hands • Return to class when finished (no loitering) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wear your seatbelt • Park only in designated spots • Keep seat belt on • Follow CEHS handbook in regard to driving • Enter/exit building purposefully
Take Care of Each Other	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Work with others on a course related task, never speaking above a whisper • After 10 minutes, students may move quietly from one resource to the next, never speaking above a whisper 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Report bullying or harassment to the main office • Be helpful and courteous to your peers, guests, and visitors 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remain in cafeteria or stand along edges of gallery level to keep hallway clear 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flush the toilets 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drive the speed limit • Be aware of other drivers • Report inappropriate behavior
Take Care of the Place	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drinks and food are permitted only in the cafeteria • Use the specific receptacles (garbage vs. recyclables) • Leave the area clean and free of trash 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Throw trash in trash cans • Place recyclables in appropriate containers • Report unsafe conditions to the main office • Use school property in a proper way 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Throw away your trash • Take your tray to the window • Keep food in the cafeteria • Throw away trash prior to entering the building 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Keep the area clean • Put trash in cans • Be mindful of others personal space • Keep the floor dry • Report any graffiti or vandalism 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Throw away trash in cans • Park only in designated spots

Take Care of Yourself	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enter the office quietly • Approach the appropriate adult and ask for assistance • Follow adult instructions 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listen actively • Give full attention • Ask for clarification 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Move to the area in which your specific bus arrives • Line up and wait in your specific bus line • Be mindful and respectful of personal space while waiting • Wait until your bus has come to a complete stop and unloaded any transferring passengers before boarding 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Access the commons at appropriate times - prior to school, after school, and during lunch • Use language appropriate to CEHS 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrive on time and be ready to work • Take an active positive role in classroom activities • Follow and respond appropriately to adult instruction • Know and follow classroom rules • Use appropriate volume and language
Take Care of Each Other	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Address adults in a respectful manner • Sit quietly while waiting for assistance 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listen actively • Be courteous to those around you 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be mindful and respectful of others' personal space while waiting • Allow others to get to their designated areas without disruption 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Report inappropriate behavior • Be mindful and respectful of others' personal space 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be mindful and respectful of others' personal space • Use appropriate volume and language
Take Care of the Place	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open and close doors quietly • Sit in a seat in an appropriate manner 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give full attention • Treat environment respectfully 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leave the area clean and free of trash 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Throw trash in appropriate containers • Keep area clean 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Keep your area clean • Report vandalism /graffiti to the teacher immediately • Stow books & bags out of isles of passage

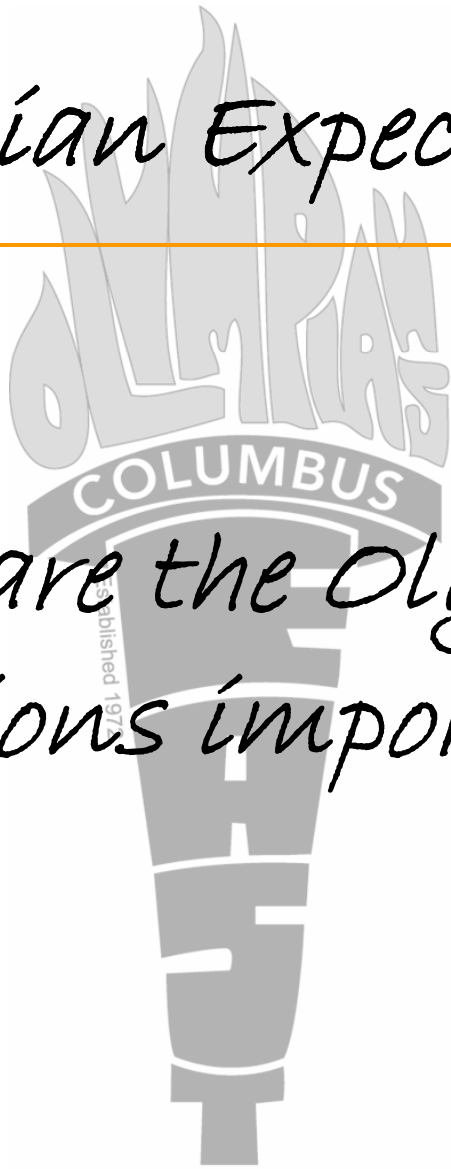
Non-Example Behavior
