

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY SHEET

Dress Code

Boys

- A. Cargo pants or dress pants. Must fit well and not be "baggy." No jeans or shorts.
- B. Shirt with collar. No words or pictures.
- C. No sweats or shorts.
- D. Sweaters, light jacket.
- E. Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- F. Comfortable shoes. No Flip-flops, crocs, sandals. Shoes must have a strap or enclosure for the heel.
- G. No hats, bandannas, chains, etc.

Girls

- A. Nice pants, dresses, skirts. No short skirts/dresses. No jeans or shorts.
- B. Blouse, sweater, light jacket. No writing or pictures.
- C. No sweats or shorts.
- D. Blouses must be tucked in at all times.
- E. Comfortable shoes. No Flip-flops, crocs, sandals. Shoes must have a strap or enclosure for the heel.
- F. Capri type pants that present a more formal, dressed up appearance.
- G. No hats, bandannas, etc.

Discipline and Grades

It is expected that all students participating in the 6th grade trip exhibit good scholarship and be good citizens at Columbus Signature Academy. The following guidelines will be followed for all students:

1. In order to participate, all students must be passing all classes. Final determination for grades will be made on May 1st, 2011, to confirm our reservations with our travel agent, hotel and bus lines. Students will be removed for academic and/or disciplinary reason up to and including the day we leave for Chicago.
2. Any student receiving a suspension from school (whether in-school or out of school) for a serious violation of school rules will NOT attend the 6th grade trip. This includes fighting or assault, substance abuse violations, or bringing a weapon to school.
3. Any student receiving a suspension from school (whether in-school or out of school) for a less serious violation of school rules will be placed on probation for the trip. Subsequent incident referrals, including detention, will result with that student being removed from the trip.
4. Any student, who is determined to not be in good standing with any teacher, will not be allowed to participate.
5. **Students who are removed from the trip for grades, discipline issues, illness, or who choose not to go, after March 21st, 2012, will not receive any refund.**
